Aaron Russell, 99, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died February 1, 2014 at the Willard Walker Hospice Home in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was born August 30, 1914 at Loy, Arkansas, the son of John Riley and Lillie Carter Russell. He was a farmer and had lived most of his life in Madison County. He was of the Pentecostal faith, a musician and loved Christian hymns. He played Banjo, Fiddle and could sing both high and low notes. He also enjoyed raising cattle, being out of doors, talking on the telephone and just talking to everyone.
