



## Alton Wayne Fonville

June 5, 1930 - June 4, 2020

Alton Wayne Fonville was born June 5, 1930, in Seymour, TX, to R. B. and Louetta Fonville and passed this life on June 4, 2020, lacking one day reaching the age of 90. Alton married Leta Chandler on October 4, 1952, in Dallas, Texas. He spent four years in the Air Force working on electronics of the B-36 Bomber. After discharge from the Air Force, he became a private pilot and enjoyed flying for the Civil Air Patrol.

After working 15 years in radio and television repair in Pecos, Texas, and Caribou, Maine, the family moved to the DFW metroplex where he taught electronics for 24 years. When he retired, they moved to the St.

Paul/Pettigrew area where they were living at the time of his death. They were members of the Combs Church of Christ.

Alton was preceded in death by his parents R.B. and Louetta Fonville; his brothers Brantley, Herschel, Marcus, Jesse, and James; and his sisters Mildred McDaniel, Helen Cline, and Inez Maher.
