



## Andrew Jackson Boyd

October 17, 1916 - April 4, 2008

Andrew Jackson "Jack" Boyd, 91, of Springdale, Arkansas, died April 4, 2008 at the Fayetteville Veterans Home. He was born October 17, 1916 at Hindsville, Arkansas, the son of Jesse and Elizabeth Hardin Boyd. He had retired from the Physical Plant Department of the University of Arkansas and was later employed by Tyson's Foods in Springdale. He was a veteran of World War Two, serving in the United States Navy and was an ordained Baptist minister in the Free Will Baptist Ministry.
