Arthur "Jerry" Gerald Stiles was born on December 3, 1943, in Camden, Arkansas. He was raised in the Fort Smith area and graduated from Northside High School, Class of 1961.

Shortly after graduation he enlisted into the Air Force and was stationed in the Philippines. When his tour of duty was up, he moved to Fayetteville to begin a long career in the food industry. It was at this time he learned the fine art of the burger, something he would become locally famous for in the future. He spearheaded the food truck movement in Arkansas, long before it was the fashionable thing to do. He and his brother, Bill, served the fraternities, sororities, and dormitories all over campus at the University of Arkansas. Like his mother Grace, he too worked in kitchens and catering, Baldwin Piano, and Hearn Electric.

He met his future wife, Cheryl, and they began a marriage and business partnership that would last the next 40 years. They ran many businesses in the Northwest Arkansas Mall in the 80's and early 90's, including Tacos n Spuds, Good Stuff, Jerry's Hickory Pit, and Soup, Salad and Subs. Mall rent increased substantially in the mid 90's and Art and Cheryl decided to venture into new territory, the bar business. Art's Place was born in 1995 and still survives and thrives today. Art's place is known for its famous burgers, reasonable prices and tight-knit clientele. Art loved Fayetteville, the Hogs, playing cards, enjoying libations with friends, and being generous with anyone who was in need.

He is survived by his wife, Cheryl; brother, Bill; Sister-in-law Julia and Charles Holiday; children, Scott, Sheri, Slate and Jerry; grandchildren, Forrest, Callie, Becca, Mattie, Stephanie, Randall and River; and too many family members to name, by both blood and relationship.
