August 13, 1926 - January 29, 2008

Augustus Clifford "Gus" Boatright, 81, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died January 29, 2008 at his home. He was born August 13, 1926 at Whitener, Arkansas, the son of James Cephus and Cora Ethel Byrd Boatright. He was a farmer and had served as Madison County Veterans Service Officer for six and one-half years. He was a veteran of World War Two, serving in the United States Army. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Hindsville, a fifty-one year member of Little Springs Lodge #230, Free and Accepted Masons, a life member of Post #10,021, Veterans of Foreign Wars at Huntsville, a life member of Hayes-Smith Post #137, American Legion at Huntsville, and a member of the Hindsville Riding Club. He loved his family, his church, his horses and chuckwagon cooking. He was preceded in death by one grandson, Cory McLoud, three brothers and four sisters.
