Billie J. Stafford, 89, of Hindsville, Arkansas, died August 18, 2009 at Meadowview Healthcare and Rehab in Huntsville. He was born March 25, 1920 at Clifty, Arkansas, the son of George William and Lula Stanback Stafford. He was a merchant, a former Madison County Tax Assessor and Justice of the Peace and a veteran of World War Two, serving in the United States Army. He was a member of Hayes-Smith Post #137, American Legion at Huntsville, the Madison County Democrat Party and was preceded in death by his wives, Jewell Isley Stafford on February 28, 1977 and Margaret Lowery Stafford on November 29, 2005.
