Charles Raymond "Bo" Duncan, 70, of Georgetown, Arkansas, died May 13, 2008 at the Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville. He was born September 21, 1937 at West Orange, California, the son of Odis and Rosa Holloway Duncan. He had retired from Navco in Fayetteville and had been an ordained minister for over forty years.
