Charles Kay Grubbs, 83, of Huntsville; passed away Saturday, March 18, 2023, at Willard Walker Hospice, Fayetteville. He was born Sunday, April 9, 1939, at Huntsville; to Otto and Ollie Pauline Lacy Grubbs.

Charles married Patricia Ann Phillips on Friday, October 7, 1962, at Huntsville; and together they were parents to one daughter, Andrea. He was a teacher for the Huntsville School District for many years and a member of the National Education Association and the Arkansas Education Association. Charles was a devoted Christian, a great dad, and a bit of a prankster. His hobbies included fishing, making lures, boating, waterskiing, and gardening; he often shared his produce, including prize-winning tomatoes, with others. Charles was also known as a master craftsman of woodworking and cabinet making. Other joys in Charles' life included his dogs, grilling, feeding the birds and squirrels in his yard, researching genealogy, and listening to music, especially Elvis, the 1950s, and classic country.

Charles was preceded in death by his parents, Otto and Ollie Grubbs; and one grandson, Mark Charles Korte Scott. He is survived by his wife, Patricia Grubbs, of the home; their daughter, Andrea Grubbs, of Fayetteville; one granddaughter and grandson-in-law, Kersten and Matthew Landis, of Fayetteville; many cousins, and many friends.

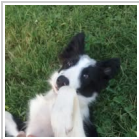
