



Charles Patrick Mannon

March 29, 1949 - August 12, 2024

Charles Patrick Mannon, 75, of Huntsville answered the Lord's call home on August 12, 2024. Pat was born March 29, 1949, in Mansfield, AR, the son of Bermond Mannon and Anna "Leona" (Slate) Mannon. He was preceded in death by both parents and a beloved stepmother, Ava Nell (Blythe) Mannon.

Pat was a friendly classmate and athlete, graduating from Mansfield High in 1967 and attending Henderson State University. In 1970, he married Marcia Cooper of Greenwood and was introduced to the teachings of the Church of Christ. His only child, Julie, would also be born that year. In 1973, he obeyed the gospel—a decision that proved pivotal in igniting his life's purpose. Self-taught, Pat studied the Bible voraciously and would soon leave a promising career at ABF to enter into ministry full-time in 1976. He would go on to help establish churches and further the growth of The Church for the next 48 years, evangelizing, holding gospel meetings, teaching online, writing, and baptizing countless souls.

From both the pulpit and studying in peoples' homes, Pat became a loyal friend, trusted counselor, and loving father-figure to many. Pat married Shirley (Wages) Baker in 1986 and proudly gained a stepson, Edwin Baker.

Pat's dedication to serving the needs of people was at the forefront of his priorities, with a fond devotion to family second; he also loved Razorback

football and baseball, his home state of Arkansas, and deer hunting. But he will be most remembered for his impressive recall of scripture, his humor, teaching ability, and a seemingly never-ending supply of Bazooka bubblegum.

Pat is survived by his wife, Shirley; daughter Julie Mannon; son Edwin Baker and wife Angie; grandson Levi Baker and wife Felicity Johnson; granddaughter Aubrey (Edie) Pappanastos and husband Andy and their two children; brother Joe Mannon and wife Kay of Mena; brother Neal Mannon and wife Shanna of Greenwood; and beloved nieces and nephews.

Viewing will be Friday, August 16, with family visitation from 5-7pm at Brashears Funeral Home in Huntsville. Funeral services are at 10am Saturday, August 17, at the Charles H Berry Gymnasium in Huntsville, with private burial at the New Home Cemetery.
