Charline Olivia Bowline, 63, of Hindsville, Arkansas, died November 18, 2007 at the Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville. She was born April 10, 1944 at Houston, Texas, the daughter of Rudolph Hilmer and Charlie Reagan McPhail Theis. She had retired from the Huntsville Public Schools after thirty-two years of service as a first grade teacher and counselor. She had earned the Bachelor of Science in Education and Master of Science in Education degrees from the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville. She was a member of Presley Chapel United Methodist Church and Delta Kappa Gamma. Survivors include: her husband, Terry Lynn Bowline of the home; two daughters, Dawn R.
