Clifton Ewell (Cliff) Wood of Huntsville passed away on December 9, 2021.

He was born on April 19, 1941 to J. Virgil and Freida (Masterson) Wood, who predeceased him. Cliff is survived by his wife of 61 years, Nancy Sue (Fitch) Wood; children Bradley Wood and wife Joan of Placitas, New Mex.; Dr. Greg Wood and wife Dorothy of Theresa, Wisc.; and, Dina Wood of Springdale, Ark. Cliff is also survived by his amazing grandchildren, Cliff Alan Wood, a graduate student at the Georgia Institute of Technology; and Nina Noelle Wood, a pre-medical student at the University of Wisconsin. Cliff was dedicated to his family, church, and cattle farm. He was a faithful member of the Hartwell Church of Christ.
