Clyde Allen Foster, 78, of Huntsville; passed away Tuesday, April 7, 2026, at Northwest Medical Center, Springdale. He was born Wednesday, October 8, 1947, at Purdy; to Noel Allen and Maxine Spradling Foster.

Clyde was united in marriage to Connie Ilean Scott on Saturday, December 20, 1969, in Huntsville, at the 1st Assembly of God church. Together, they built a life centered on love and devotion, raising three awesome sons Alex, Brad, and Craig.

Well known for his quick wit, humor, and a touch of orneriness that endeared him to family and friends. In his younger years, he was athletic and enjoyed playing softball, and he embraced adventure, spending time kayaking, hunting, and riding motorcycles, until he chose to set that aside after the birth of his first son, Alex. A faithful member of Huntsville First Assembly of God, Clyde served as a deacon and lay pastor. He faithfully took part in satellite churches, sharing his faith with sincerity and conviction. He held a deep love for his church family and loved the Lord.

Above all, Clyde cherished his family. His grandchildren were his pride and joy, bringing him immense happiness and fulfillment. He will be remembered for his strong work ethic, his generous spirit, his humor, and the love he so freely gave to those around him.
