Donald Wayne Herring, 74, of Witter; passed away Sunday, April 26, 2026, at Washington Regional Medical Center, in Fayetteville. He was born Tuesday, January 29, 1952, at Fort Worth, Texas; to JB and Johnnie Belle Grissom Herring.
