January 30, 1940 - March 16, 2026

Doris Gaskill Williams, age 86, died on March 16, 2026. She was born in Huntsville, Arkansas, on January 30, 1940, and graduated from Huntsville High School. In August of 1963 she married Tom Williams, who preceded her in death. Doris received a B.A. degree from Central Oklahoma State College and worked as Secretary to the President of Oklahoma Christian College for several years. She and Tom then moved to San Marcos, Texas, and she finished her career as a senior accountant at Southwest Texas State (now Texas State University). After their retirement, she and Tom moved to Johnson, Arkansas, and enjoyed several years near the area in which she grew up.

In 2022, Doris, a beautiful and intelligent woman, was diagnosed with dementia—the long goodbye.

In addition to Tom, she was also predeceased by her parents, John W. and Hester Guthrie Gaskill; her four brothers: Jim, Ed, Bob, and Johnnie Gaskill; one sister, Mary Neal, and their spouses; one nephew, Tim Gaskill, and one niece, Cheryl Matthews. She is survived by her sister, Ann Gaskill Anderson (spouse Joel); six nephews: Hugh Gaskill, Bob and Michael Neal, Lincoln, Deverick and Mitchell Anderson; and six nieces: Susan Garland, Brenda Mathews, Janet Harriman, Regina Clark, Michelle Gardner, and Sherri Cozad.

There will be a memorial service at the Brashears Funeral Home chapel in Huntsville at 10 a.m. Saturday, April 11. Her ashes will be buried in the Sparks Cemetery in Huntsville at a later date.
