Francisco Olivera "Pancho", de 38 años, falleció el domingo 29 de septiembre de 2024 por la mañana en el Centro Médico Regional de Washington en Fayetteville, AR. Nació en Santiago Yucuyachi, Oaxaca, México, el martes 17 de junio de 1986, hijo de su madre, Soccoro Silvia Alcorta Cuenca y su padre, Rafael Amadeo Olivera Amador.

Francisco se casó con su amorosa esposa, Sofía Flores, el 24 de mayo de 2019 en una ceremonia en Rogers, Arkansas. Tenían cuatro hijos juntos: Yajaira, Valeria, Yeltsin y Nayeli.
