Fred “Harold” Jones, 88, died January 21, 2023, at his Springdale home surrounded by family. He was born December 29, 1934, in Huntsville to Fred Troy and Nola Phillips Jones.

Harold was married to Mary Lou Casteel in Huntsville on December 3, 1957. They parented three sons. Harold was a beef cattle and broiler farm owner. For many years, he owned and operated Jones Conoco in Huntsville. He was well-known to everyone in town, and especially liked by students who would stop by after school for sodas and snacks. He was known to have the coldest sodas in town and was always ready to flip quarters “double or nothing” for them. Harold and Mary moved to Springdale in 2005 after retiring and selling their farm.

Harold is preceded in death by his wife, parents, and three siblings. He is survived by his three sons and daughters-in-law: Robert and Kim Jones of Springdale; Rick and Vickie Jones of Springdale; and Scott and Rebecca Jones of Berryville. He was the proud Papa of nine grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
