Geneva Hazel Faulkner, 87, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died July 13, 2008 at the Northwest Medical Center-Springdale. She was born May 28, 1921 in the Good Luck Community in Madison County, Arkansas, the daughter of The Reverend Benner Elbert and Hannah Margaret Drake Davis. She was a devoted Christian, talented singer and a member of the Living Water Baptist Church in Huntsville.
