December 11, 1924 - July 30, 2024

Goldmon James Barron was born December 11th, 1924 near Bohannon Mountain, Arkansas to Daniel Barron and Lucy McCoy Barron. He was one of seven children that grew to adulthood, all of which have now passed. He was ninety-nine and a half when he passed at Countryside Assisted Living on the evening of July 30th, 2024 of natural causes.

He served two tours of duty in the United States Armed Services, one in the South Pacific and one in Korea. He was an avid fisherman and hunter. He operated a service station at Hilltop during the 60s-70s era. He also raised beef cows, pigs, and chickens commercially. He was married to three women over the course of his long life.

He is survived by his third wife, Wanda Barron, and his son of a previous marriage, Danny Barron.

There will be a closed-casket visitation at 10:00 AM, Tuesday, August 6, 2024 at Brashears Funeral Home. Interment will follow at Colbaugh Cemetery, where Goldmon will be laid to rest beside his 2nd wife, Ruby Imogene Barron, whom he was married to for fifty-nine years.
