Hardy Yancey Todd, 80, of Huntsville; passed away Monday, October 28, 2024, at Mercy Hospital, Berryville. He was born Thursday, February 17, 1944, at Vidor, Texas; to William Hardy and Stella Mary Yancey Todd.

Hardy married Mary Lee Clark on Saturday, June 20, 1964, at Baytown, Texas; and together they were parents to four children. Hardy served his country with pride as a member of the United States Air Force, where he worked as an aircraft mechanic for many years. He had a passion for blacksmithing and woodworking, always lending a helping hand on his family's farm and generously giving his time to others.
