Harley Charles Gilliam, 87, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died December 9, 2010 at his home. He was born August 18, 1923 at Aurora, Arkansas, the son of Lewin Alman and Dora Lee Cluck Gilliam. He was a 1943 graduate of Huntsville State Vocational School where he later served as football and basketball coach. During his lifetime, he had been a policeman, a movie theatre operator, restaurant operator, a trash service employee, a newspaper employee and an employee of the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department. He was an avid hunter and was inducted into the Madison County Athletic Hall of Fame in 2010. He was preceded in death by one son, H. C.
