February 11, 1943 - July 29, 2008

Harold Douglas "Butch" Stroud, Jr., 65, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died July 29, 2008 at the Northwest Medical Center-Springdale. He was born February 11, 1943 at Huntsville, Arkansas, the son of Harold Douglas and Oneta Fleta "Bill" Dudgeon Stroud. He was a farmer and attended Living Water Baptist Church in Huntsville.
