Howard Overton McLoud, 89, of Huntsville; passed away Thursday, October 28, 2021, at Washington Regional Medical Center, Fayetteville. He was born Wednesday, March 16, 1932, at Forum; to Hoyt Overton and Arla Mae Ham McLoud.
