Jack Edward Brannan, 88, of Huntsville; passed away Sunday, March 6, 2022, at Willard Walker Hospice, Fayetteville. He was born Sunday, April 2, 1933, at Derby, Kansas; to Floyd Dale and Jessie Christina Minnich Brannan.

Jack married Alta Faye Donnohue on Saturday, February 9, 1952, at Huntsville; and together they were parents to two sons. He worked for Boeing Aircraft where he held a high-level clearance for control wiring on B52 bombers. Later in life, he worked for Campbell Soup as a maintenance manager. As a jack of all trades and master of many, Jack excelled in many areas. Among the highlights of his life was owning a Leo Quarter Horse, from the legendary sire of the American Quarter Horse world.
