Jack Bowman Canion, 80, of Witter, Arkansas, died February 29, 2008 at his home. He was born September 5, 1927 at Utopia, Texas, the son of Darrel and Cassie Halsey Canion. He had retired from the Huntsville Public Schools in 1987 after thirty years of service as a bus driver and auto mechanics teacher. He was a veteran of World Two, serving in the United States Army. He spent most of his time working on his farm, where he milked for many years before raising beef cattle. He was preceded in death by his parents and an infant brother.
