James William Fishel, 76, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died January 30, 2010 at Meadowview Healthcare and Rehab in Huntsville. He was born December 21, 1933 at Minier, Illinois, the son of Miley Virden and Helen Faye Campbell Fishel. He was a tool and diemaker for 16 years for General Electric Corporation and 19 years for Duncan Industries in Harrison.
