March 3, 1967 - October 22, 2023

James Allen Williams was born to Donald G. Williams and Glenna Wilson Williams in Huntsville, Arkansas on the 3rd day of March 1967. He died on 22 October 2023 in Columbus, Ohio.

James played in the Huntsville band. He also played football in middle school. James tied Terry McCoy of West Fork for first place individual honors at the Future Farmers of America (FFA) Forestry Judging Contest that included Benton, Madison, and Washington Counties. They had to estimate pulpwood, estimate saw timber, tree identification, and timber stand improvement. He graduated from Huntsville High School in 1985. After high school, James moved to Wichita, Kansas where he worked for his uncle who was in the pest control extermination business.

Later returning to Arkansas, he enrolled in Northwest Technical Institute, Springdale, Arkansas where he graduated in Industrial Maintenance Technology in June of 1996. He spent a couple of years studying at the University of Arkansas while also working for Auto Zone. James later became an over-the-road truck driver, following in the footsteps of his father.

James leaves behind a daughter, Victoria Sharp, and grandchildren Gavin, Kylie, Titus, Silas, and Matix of Lincoln, Arkansas; his mother Glenna Kasper, and her husband Robert of Arnold, Nebraska; his brother Don Williams and

his wife Beverly of Springdale, Arkansas; his sister Laura Williams Capasso and her husband Major General (retired) Paul Capasso of Leesburg, Virginia; his niece Claire Capasso of Colorado Springs, Colorado; a very special friend and companion, Connie Owens of Witter, Arkansas; several aunts and uncles and many cousins.
