Jerry Eldon Cook, 65, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died March 8, 2008 at the Northwest Medical Center-Springdale. He was born December 16, 1942 at Prairie Grove, Arkansas, the son of Elmer Alden and Melba Marie Sparks Cook. He was a United States Marine Corps veteran and a Baptist. After his military service, he began a 40 year career as a truck driver. He also worked as a Washington County Deputy Sheriff under Sheriff Herb Marshall and had been employed at Danaher Tool Group for ten years as a heat treat operator. He was a member of Hayes-Smith Post #137, American Legion at Huntsville. He was preceded in death by one son, Robert William Cook, his parents and one brother, Jim Hayes.
