Jimmie Dean Hobbs, 83, of Forum, Arkansas, died May 19, 2015 at the Northwest Medical Center of Springdale, Arkansas. He was born February 6, 1932 at Forum, Arkansas, the son of France McDaniel "Mack" and Opal Dee Marshall Hobbs. He was a former employee of the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department and had retired from McClinton-Anchor Construction.
