John Dwight Steele, 89, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died June 19, 2014 at Healthsouth Rehabilitation Hospital in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was born March 18, 1925 at Wharton, Arkansas, the son of Samuel Webster and Pearl Bolinger Steele. He was a long-time Huntsville businessman and had operated "It" Antiques for several years.
