Joseph Ezra Sprott, 95, of Harrison, Arkansas, died April 29, 2010 at the North Arkansas Regional Medical Center in Harrison. He was born September 22, 1914 at Auburn, Indiana, the son of Donald Potter and Hazel Ensley Sprott. He was a retired rancher and realtor, a veteran of World War Two, serving in the United States Army and a former mayor of Huntsville serving in the 1960's. He was a charter member of the Northwest Arkansas Economic Development District, a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Huntsville and had been a Freemason for sixty-six years holding life membership in Huntsville Lodge #364, Free and Accepted Masons.
