



## Juanita Curd

February 6, 1924 - August 22, 2024

Juanita Curd, 100, of Huntsville; passed away Thursday, August 22, 2024, at Meadowview Healthcare and Rehab, Huntsville. She was born Wednesday, February 6, 1924, at Plano, Texas; to Fred and Pearl Autrey Garrett.

Juanita graduated from Plano High School in 1941. She married her husband, Lloyd, on a beautiful Sunday, August 23, 1942, and together they embarked on a life of farming, growing cotton, corn, and wheat in the Plano area. Later, Juanita pursued a career in accounting, working with Employers Casualty Insurance Company and as an actuary assistant with Fidelity Union Life Insurance Company in Dallas, Texas. She also spent several years in accounting at the State Farm Insurance Regional office, also located in Dallas.

In 1964, Juanita and Lloyd moved to a farm near Huntsville, where they raised chickens and cattle. Juanita worked as a bookkeeper for Gaskill Ford Motor Company and as a secretary/bookkeeper for Crossbow Real Estate. After many fulfilling years, the farm was sold in 1991, and the couple settled into life in Huntsville. Juanita was a founding member of Faith Southern Baptist Church in Huntsville, and her Christian faith was a guiding force throughout her life. She had been a devoted member of Southern Baptist Churches since her teenage years.

Juanita is survived by her Grandson, Jason Yates and wife Mary, two great grandkids Cole Yates and wife Jessica, Emily Yates Shackelford and husband Ty, and three great-great grandkids.

Juanita was preceded in death by her husband Robert Lloyd Curd, and her parents Fred and Pearl Garrett.
