Karen Kay Robertson, 83, of Huntsville; passed away Sunday, January 15, 2023, at home. She was born Sunday, July 9, 1939, at Wichita, Kansas; to Lee Edgar and Thelma Elizabeth Tabor Neff.

Karen married Jerry Dale Robertson on Friday, July 11, 1958 at Wichita, Kansas; and together they were parents to three children. She was a farmer and a member of the Church of Christ. Karen never met a stranger, and those around her knew how much she cared about others and her community. A pillar in the community, she served as a member of the Clifty Volunteer Fire Department, the Madison County Fire Association, and Madison County Youth Sports. Additionally, she served as a deputy coroner, a first responder, and a member of the Madison County Fair Board and the Madison County Rodeo Board. In recognition of her dedication to others, Karen was named the Madison County Record's "Best of the Best - Volunteer of the Year."

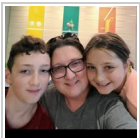
