Larry "Sonny" Pfeifer, 65, of Hindsville, Arkansas died February 6, 2009 at his home. He was born August 8, 1943 at Paragould, Arkansas the son of Leonard Edward and Florence Ola Higgins Pfeifer. He was a farmer, a former State Trooper having served ten years with the Arkansas State Police and was named Trooper of the Year in 1974 for Troop H in Fort Smith, Arkansas. He was a veteran of the United States Army and the Arkansas National Guard and was a member of I.O.O.F. #116 at Kingston, Arkansas. He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother, David Morris Pfeifer and one sister, Edna Marie Pfeifer.
