March 21, 1918 - December 24, 2011

Leo Ernest Spurlock, 93, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died December 24, 2011 at his home. He was born March 21, 1918 at Aurora, Arkansas, the son of James Everett and Rebecca McElhaney Spurlock. He was a farmer and had retired from Huntsville High School after many years as an Agri teacher. He was a graduate of the University of Arkansas and a veteran of World War Two, serving in the United States Army Air Corps. He was an Elder of the Huntsville Church of Christ, a member of Hayes-Smith Post #137, American Legion at Huntsville and a former member of the Board of Directors of Northwest Technical Institute in Springdale. He was preceded in death by his wife of sixty-seven years, Mary Elizabeth Camp Spurlock on December 6, 2011. He was also preceded in death by one son, Dennis C. Spurlock, one brother, James L. Spurlock and three sisters, Norma Keeter, Erma Owen and Mildred Kelso.
