February 20, 1928 - November 8, 2019

Maedean Lucille Scott entered Heaven's gates on November 8, 2019 at the age of 91. The youngest of eight children, Maedean was born to Samuel Ishum and Fannie Paralee Foster Miller on February 20, 1928.
