Mary Jo Brashears, 93, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died September 22, 2010 at her home. She was born September 26, 1916 at Wharton, Arkansas, the daughter of Walter Scott and Della Dotson Boomer. She was a 1934 graduate of Huntsville State Vocational School and had been a licensed funeral director for over fifty years. She served as secretary and treasurer of Brashears Funeral Home in Huntsville until her death.
