Mary Helen Glisson, 74, of Berryville, Arkansas, died February 21, 2009 at Saint John's Hospital in Berryville. She was a retired insurance agent for Farmers Mutual Insurance Company and the owner and principal broker of Mary Glisson Real Estate.
