Mildred Ruth Bumgarner, 87, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died June 14, 2008 at her home. She was born September 14, 1920 at Hutchinson, Kansas, to Mennonite Minister Reverend H. T. Unruh and his wife, Anna (Gaedert) Unruh. She was educated at Bluffton College in Ohio and at Bethel College in Newton, Kansas. She was a school teacher for more than twenty-six years in Germantown, Ohio, Lehigh, Sharon and Newton, Kansas and finally, at Huntsville. She was married on June 1, 1943 to Reverend Don V.
