Millard Maxwell Johnson, 91, of Springdale, Arkansas, died March 2, 2010 at the Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was born August 9, 1918 at Whitener, Arkansas, the son of William Fred and Betty Culwell Johnson. He was a retired water welldriller and a veteran of World War Two, serving in the United States Army Air Corps. He was a member of the Mountain Springs Missionary Baptist Church and Springdale Lodge #316, Free and Accepted Masons. He was preceded in death by his wife, Helen Mason Johnson on May 19, 2002.
