Ramona “Mona” Louise Villines, 90, of Huntsville; passed away Monday, December 8, 2025, at her home. She was born on Tuesday, November 26, 1935, at Kingston, Arkansas; to Howard Ervin and Sara Etta Jane Steele Garton.
