Nellie Mae Patrick Johnson, 86, of Wesley, Arkansas, died May 31, 2011 at The Maples at Har-Ber Meadows in Springdale, Arkansas. She was born May 13, 1925 in El Dorado, Oklahoma, the daughter of William Alexander and Nellie Mae Wood Ellis.
