Patricia Faye Laird Vaughan, 76, of Hindsville, passed away Tuesday, October 15, 2019 at home. She was born July 17, 1943 at on High School Hill in Huntsville, the daughter of Fay and Rea C. Elzey Laird. Pat married a 1960 classmate, Jim Vaughan, in 1962. She was a graduate of Fayetteville Business College and received her business degree from the University of Arkansas.
