Randy Ray Treat, 71, of Kingston, Arkansas, died August 26, 2017 at the Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was born December 7, 1945 at Tulsa, Oklahoma, the son of Buford and Evelyn Darlene Alexander Treat. He was a retired Battalion Chief for the Springdale Fire Department and also retired from the Kingston Rural Volunteer Fire Department. He was also a retired agriculture teacher and held a Master's degree in Education. He was serving as vice president of the Board of the Jasper School District and had served as a Captain in the Arkansas Army National Guard and was a member of American Legion Post #230 at Kingston, Arkansas.
