



## Robert Curd

April 18, 1920 - January 30, 2021

Robert Lloyd Curd, 100, passed away January 30, 2021 at Huntsville. He was born April 18, 1920, near Garland, Texas, which is now part of the Dallas Metroplex. His parents were John and Edith Curd. He was the youngest of seven children; five sisters and one brother, all deceased.

During World War II, Lloyd served in the infantry and was later discharged to assist his father in farming. At that time, food and fiber were very important to the war effort. Lloyd continued to farm until retirement.

On August 23, 1942; Lloyd married Juanita Garrett. They celebrated their 78th wedding anniversary on August 23, 2020. Lloyd was a Baptist and had been a member of a Southern Baptist church since youth. He had been a member of Faith Baptist Church in Huntsville, Arkansas since shortly after the church was organized. Since youth, his hobby had been playing Country Western Swing music, playing several instruments. He was one of the early members of the Arkansas Fiddlers Association.

He is survived by his wife, Juanita Garrett Curd, of the home; and grandson, Jason Yates and wife, Mary, of Huntsville.
