Robert Harry Winner, 95, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died January 28, 2015 at his home. He was born May 17, 1919 at Nora Springs, Iowa, the son of Walter and Grace Westfall Winner. He moved with his family to Southgate, California when he was ten years old due to Bob's severe asthma. His Dad died when he was twelve. He graduated from Southgate High School.
