Ronald Dean Davis, 65, of Edmond, Oklahoma, beloved husband of Belinda Whorton Davis, died Monday, November 9, 2009 after a brief illness that began with pneumonia. Ron was born March 7, 1944 at Wichita, Kansas, the son of Merle E. and Amo Harris Davis. He was preceded in death by his parents, a younger brother, Larry J. Davis and his grandparents, Daniel and Maude Davis of Hindsville, Arkansas and Grover and Annie Harris of Huntsville, Arkansas. Ron always worked in sales because he enjoyed people. He work for B & W Company in Springfield, MO, Aaron's Transmissions in Springfield, MO and Arlington, TX. He had a Mac Tools Distributorship in Arlington, TX and Oklahoma City, OK. He truly enjoyed a part-time job at Love's Country Stores. He retired from Lance Foods in Edmond, OK in March 2009. Ron served in the U. S. Navy from January 1967 to October 1970, receiving an Honorable Discharge. He seved on the U. S. S. Wasp CVS-18 and on the U. S. S. Essex for the retrieval of the first manned mission in the Apollo program, Apollo 7, in October 1968. Ron was a kind loving husband, dad and papa. He was a Christian and a member of the First Christian Church in Edmond, OK. He enjoyed wood-crafting, his motor scooter, traveling with the fifth wheel, crappie fishing (especially with his father-in-law, Guy Whorton) grand-daughter, little Hattie and the "kids" his poodles, Pepper, Fluffy and Baby, email, Ebay, HGTV and the Dallas Cowboys. He as a lifetime "dyed in the wool" Democrat. Ron truly believed he was going to beat this illness and fought so hard for weeks. There were many
