Ronnie Willhite, 91, of Fayetteville passed away Thursday, January 19, 2023, at his home. He was born Wednesday, April 8, 1931, at Beaver, Arkansas to George Edward and Wilsie Beaver Willhite.

Ronnie married Shirley Ann Eaton on Saturday, November 27, 1971, at Fayetteville. For the last 25 years he attended Cross Church at Springdale. Ronnie's work ethic began as he worked in his father's handle manufacturing company. Before serving his country in the US Army, he worked building bridges and dams. He then began his own lumber business. In 1980, he and his wife expanded their business to include pallet lumber. They owned and operated Willhite Forest Products, Inc. together until 2002. Ronnie took great joy in all aspects of the lumber business and in inventing new equipment. He was a hard worker who loved his wife and family and was well-respected by all who knew him. Some of his pastimes were telling stories, singing, riding four-wheelers, boating, playing pool, making the best lemonade, and visiting with people of all walks of life.

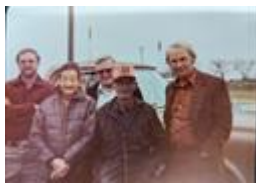
