



## Sarah Elizabeth Hargis

July 9, 1919 - February 24, 2008

Sarah Elizabeth "Betsy" Hargis, 88, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died February 24, 2008 at the Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville. She was born July 9, 1919 at Fayetteville, Arkansas, the daughter of Arthur G. and A. Eulala Johnson Sandford. She was a 1945 graduate of the University of Arkansas and had retired from the Arkansas Department of Human Services in 1980.
