Shirley Jo Treat, 73, of Kingston, passed from this life, surrounded by dear friends and family on July 4, 2018. She was born in Berryville, on June 9, 1945. She graduated from Fayetteville High School, then in her later years, went on to graduate with her Bachelor's Degree in Business from John Brown University. Shirley was married to her best friend, Randy Treat, on February 18, 1966, in Fayetteville. They celebrated 51 glorious years together before Randy's passing just ten short months ago.
