Tillman LeRoy Lane, 75, of Hindsville; passed away Saturday, August 30, 2025. He was born Tuesday, September 27, 1949; to Albert and Sadie Lane.

He was a cattleman for Vaughn Valley Cattle Company for 47 years and Bar B Bar Farm from 2015 till his passing. He knew everything there was to know about cattle.
